
VISIT TO KALESHWARAM PROJECT

The Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project is a multi-purpose irrigation project on the Godavari River in Kaleshwaram, Bhoopalpally, Telangana. Currently the world's largest multi-stage lift irrigation project. The Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project is divided into 7 links and 28 packages spanning a distance of approximately 500 km (310 mi) through 13 districts and utilizing a canal network of more than 1,800 km (1,100 mi). The project aims to produce a total of 240 TMC (195 from Medigadda Barrage, 20 from Sripada Yellampalli project and 25 from groundwater), of which 169 has been allocated for irrigation, 30 for Hyderabad municipal water, 16 for miscellaneous industrial uses and 10 for drinking water in nearby villages, with the remainder being estimated evaporation loss.

We visited 'Kaleshwaram project' of karimnagar on 20-09-2019. II, III, IV year students marked the attendance for the tour. Students witnessed Iconic project works like construction of Dam, constructing reservoir and Japanese pumping systems. It was a good practical experience for students.








