- In respect of under Graduate Professional Courses in Engineering (including Technology) and B.Pharmacy the candidate should have completed 16 years of age as on 31-12-2023.
- In respect of Pharm D (Doctor of Pharmacy) Course the candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2023.
- However maximum eligible age for obtaining a scholarship is 25 years for OC candidates and 29 years for other candidates as on 01-07-2023 as per the guidelines prescribed in Memo No. 10537/SW(Edn.2)/2011,dated: 20-10-2012 and further guidelines issued from time to time by Social Welfare (Edn.) Department shall apply.
- Mere appearing for TSEAMCET-2023 and obtaining a rank does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission automatically unless the candidate fulfils the requirements laid down for admissions.

ATTENTION TO NOT QUALIFIED NOT APPEARED TSEAMCET -2023 MINORITY CANDIDATES:

 Update the information and pay the Processing Fee of Rs. 600/- (for SC/ST) and Rs. 1200/- (for Others) through online payment (Credit Card / Debit Card / NetBanking) / T-Wallet.

SLOT BOOKING FOR CERTIFICATE VERIFICATION:

- All categories (OC/EWS/BC/SC/ST/MINORITY) candidates, Book your Slot (Selection of Help Line Center, Date & Time) to attend Certificate Verification at your nearest or convenient Help Line Center (HLC) mentioned in Annexure-I within the scheduled dates and attend for the Certificate Verification accordingly. Without payment of Processing Fee and Slot Booking, the candidate is not permitted to attend for Certificate Verification.  - b) The Ex-Servicemen have to produce the Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP) certificate issued by respective Regional Sainik Welfare Officer as per Appendix-"A" Attached with supporting documents to establish the Permanent address / Home town declared by Ex-Servicemen while joining the service and as recorded in their Service Register in accordance with G.O, such as Certificate from Records Office, Education Certificates of Ex-Servicemen etc.
 - c) Serving Defence Personnel including CRPF and BSF Personnel should submit a Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP) certificate issued by Unit Commanding Officer (not less than the rank of a Colonel/ equivalent in Navy and Air Force Commandant in CRPF/BSF) as per Appendix-"B" Attached along with original and attested copy of Service Register where the Permanent address / Home town declared by them while joining the service is mentioned along with the education certificates of the Serving Defence personnel.
 - d) The retired CRPF and BSF Personnel have to produce the Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP) certificate issued by their respective Competent Authority as per Appendix-A along with supporting documents to establish the Permanent address / Home Town declared by them while joining the service and as recorded in their Service Register in accordance with G.O, such as Certificate from Records Office, Education Certificates of CRPF/ BSF personnel, etc.
- > NCC (National Cadet Corps)- Certificates issued by Competent Authorities.
- Sports (SG)-Sports Achievements / Testimonials along with the For IV duly certified / attested by the concerned State Sports Association

PROCEDURE FOR EXERCISING OPTIONS:

- Immediately after Certificate Verification, the Login Id will be sent to the candidates registered Mobile Number. All the messages / OTPs / Allotment details etc., will be sent to the Registered Mobile Number, hence advised to keep the mobile with you till the end of admission process.

ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

- The Provisional First Phase allotment of seats will be made on or before
 12-07-2023 and will be placed in the website https://tseamcet.nic.in.
 - For downloading the candidate's **Provisional Allotment Order**, enter the ROC Form Number, TSEAMCET Hall Ticket Number, Password and Date of Birth in Candidate login in https://tseamcet.nic.in.
 - Pay the Tuition Fee mentioned in the Provisional allotment order through online (Credit Card / Debit Card/ Net Banking) within the prescribed time and self report through online system in candidates login and take admission number to confirm the provisionally allotted seat. Take the printout.
 - The candidates with zero Tuition Fee mentioned on provisional allotment order, shall perform the self reporting within the prescribed date through online system in candidates login and take admission number to confirm the provisionally allotted seat. Take the printout.
 - All the candidates have to pay a minimum of Rs. 5000/- (SC/ST) and Rs. 10000/- (Others) along with Tuition Fee where the Tuition Fee to be paid by the candidate is less than Rs. 5000/-(SC/ST) and Rs. 10000/- (Others).The same will be returned back to the candidates who report at the allotte after final phase. If the candidate did not report at the allotte same will be forfeited.

- The candidate at the time of self reporting shall give an undertaking through online that he / she will relinquish the admission through Degree Online Services Telangana (DOST), if any.
- After first phase, if the candidate cancels admission through Online after payment of Tuition Fee and exercise options in subsequent phases if any, Tuition Fee paid earlier shall be considered for subsequent allotment of seat and forfeiture of amount will be applicable as mentioned below.

• If the candidate cancels his / her admission will forfeit the Tuition Fee paid as mentioned below.

- After first phase, after payment of Tuition Fee, if the candidate cancels the provisionally allotted seat through online on or before the cut off date notified for cancellation in first phase as mentioned in allotment order, full Tuition Fee paid will be refunded.
- 50% after second phase and before cut off date notified for cancellation as mentioned in allotment order and 100% thereafter in respect of Private Unaided and University colleges.

SECOND PHASE AND FINAL PHASE:

The eligible candidates can attend for Certificate Verification and exercise options in Second and Final Phase, if they have not attended earlier and can exercise options.

The candidates who have participated in First Phase Counselling can exercise options using their old password, Login ID, for the leftover seats now consequential vacancies that may arise in the process of allotment as per

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mentioned above, and it is advised to exercise options for interested colleges only assuming that vacancies are available in the course of their choice.

WHO CAN EXERCISE OPTIONS IN SECOND PHASE AND FINAL PHASE?

- Candidates who have secured seat but not interested to join.
- Who have not secured seat so far but got their certificates verified.
- Who have not exercised the options so far but got their certificates verified.
- Who have secured a seat, self reported and aspiring for a better option.
- NCC and Sports category candidates whose certificates were submitted and got verified during First Phase of counselling have to exercise options in Second Phase and Final Phase to consider their candidature for NCC and Sports category seats.
- And any other eligible candidates.

NOTE:

- **1.** Options given in the First Phase will not be considered for allotment and candidates have to exercise option afresh in Second Phase and Final Phase.

2. Eligibility Criteria to appear for TS EAMCET-2023:

Candidates satisfying the following requirements shall be eligible to appear for TS EAMCET-2023:

- a) Candidates should be of Indian Nationality or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card Holders.
- **b**) Candidates should belong to the state of Telangana / Andhra Pradesh. The candidates should satisfy local / non–local status requirements as laid down in the Telangana / Andhra Pradesh Education Institutions (Regulations of Admission) order, 1974 as subsequently amended.

c) For B.E. / B.Tech. in Engineering, Bio-Technology, B.Tech. (Dairy Technology), B.Tech. (Ag. Engineering) and for 50% seats in B.Pharmacy & B.Tech. (Food Technology (FT)) Courses:

Candidates should have passed or appeared at the final year of the Diploma examination in Engineering conducted by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh.

- (ii) The <u>minimum eligibility criteria</u>: At least 45% and 40% marks for candidates belongs to Unreserved and reserved category respectively in the subjects specified (MPC / BiPC) taken together at 10+2 pattern.
- (iii) In the case of Engineering and Pharmacy courses, candidates should have completed 16 years of age, as on 31st December of the year of admission. There is no upper age limit.
- (iv) In the case of B.Tech. (Dairy Technology), B.Tech. (Ag. Engineer Technology), Candidates should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st of admission and an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates and Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates as on 31st December of the Sreyas Institute of En

(Nursing): Candidates should have passed or appeared for the final year of Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) or any examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh with any two / three of the subjects indicated against each course noted given below. - (i) Candidates should have passed or appeared for the final year of Intermediate examination (10+2 pattern) with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics or Biology optionals conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh or any other examination recognized by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh as equivalent thereto or should have passed or appeared at the final year of the Diploma examination in Pharmacy course conducted by the Telangana / Andhra Pradesh State Board of Technical Education and Training or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the Telangana / Andhra Pradesh State Board of Technical Education and Training.
- (ii) Candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission to the course.

3. Normalization of Question Paper

TS EAMCET-2023 is being conducted in multiple sessions based on the same syllabus, same pattern for candidates having same eligibility criteria. A candidate will be eligible to appear only in one session. Since the question paper is different for each session, there is a possibility that the candidates may compare themselves about the variation in the difficulty levels of question paper of the same subject. However, it may be noted that utmost care will be taken so that all the subjects are of the same standard. Further, it is decided to adopt a normalization process to eliminate any such variations in the difficulty levels of various sessions.

The main aim of the Normalization is to ensure that no student gets advantage/disadvantage due to multiple sessions. The normalization process brings all the candidates across all sessions on a comparative scale. Due to this process, the marks of the easy session may be reduced marginally and marks of hard session may increase marginally on the global scale. This depends exactly on the average performance in each session. Since care is taken to prepare papers of equal difficulty, these changes are expected to be very marginal. Normalized marks justify the candidates while respecting their actual performance. Hence, the following normalization procedure is adopted which is being followed by other competitive Examinations in India to avoid advantage/disadvantage to candidates in a particular session compared to the other sessions.

Normalized marks of the candidate

= $GASD + \frac{(GTA-GASD)}{(STA-SASD)} x$ (Marks obtained by the candidate in the subject in a session – SASD)

Where,

SASD: Sum of Average (A) and Standard Deviation (SD) of the subject of a session in which the candidate appeared.

GASD: Sum of Average (A) and Standard Deviation (SD) of all the candidates across all sessions of the subject put together.

STA: Average mark of the top 0.1% of the candidates in the subject of a session in which the candidate appeared.

GTA: Average mark of the top 0.1% of all the candidates across all the sessions of the subject put together.

Note: For the candidates for whom there is no qualifying cut-off in TS EAMCET-2023, if the marks in TS EAMCET-2023 after normalization go below zero (negative), the mark is treated as zero. If the tie persists, then TS EAMCET-2023 normalization marks (though negative) are considered for resolving the tie.

- 4. Criteria for Ranking: Is applicable to the candidates who have secured qualifying marks (normalized marks) in then TS EAMCET-2023 and candidates belonging to the category of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe, for whom qualifying marks have not been prescribed. The TS EAMCET-2023 ranks will be purely allotted purely based on the performance (normalized marks) in the TS EAMCET-2023 examination and the 25% weightage for intermediate marks in the TS EAMCET-2023 examination ranks has been waived off as a special case for the TS EAMCET-2023 similar to the TS EAMCET-2021 & 2022.
- 5. Submission of the Online Application form for Engineering (E) and Agriculture and Medical (AM) streams:

Candidates with Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry / Bio-Tech. / Biology as optional subjects in their Intermediate or its equivalent course should submit "E" stream online application for Engineering B.E./ B.Tech. (Ag. Engineering.) / B.Tech. (Dairy Technology) / B.Tech.(FT) / B.Pharm (MPC)/ Pharm-D (MPC) courses.

Candidates with Biology, Physics and Chemistry as optional subjects in their Interme course should submit "AM" stream online application for B.Sc. (Hons.) Agricu Horticulture / B.Sc. (Forestry)/ B.V.Sc. & AH / B.F.Sc. / B.Tech. (FT) /B.Pharm. / B.T. (Bi.P.C.) / Pharm-D (Bi.P.C)/B.Sc (Nursing) courses. For B.Tech. (Bio-Technology) (Bi.P.C), candidates shallor pass / appear for Bridge Course exam in Mathematics conducted by B.I.E, A.P. / T.S. as per G.O. 17, dtd.02-02-2008.

In respect of candidates belongs to the Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe or other special category of student as specified by the Government from time to time, marks required for admission shall be 10% less than that prescribed for general category.
