Academician (Nominated by the Management): Dr. C.Krishna Mohan appreciated the CRT and Placements' improvements in the college.















Bandlaguda, Nagole, Hyderabad, affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad, Kukatpally, Hyderabad, for a period of Ten (10) Years from the Academic Year 2022-23 to 2031-32 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.4(i) of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018 and requested the University to issue conferment orders as per UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations 2018 for Autonomous Colleges and subsequent regulations issued from time to time by the University.

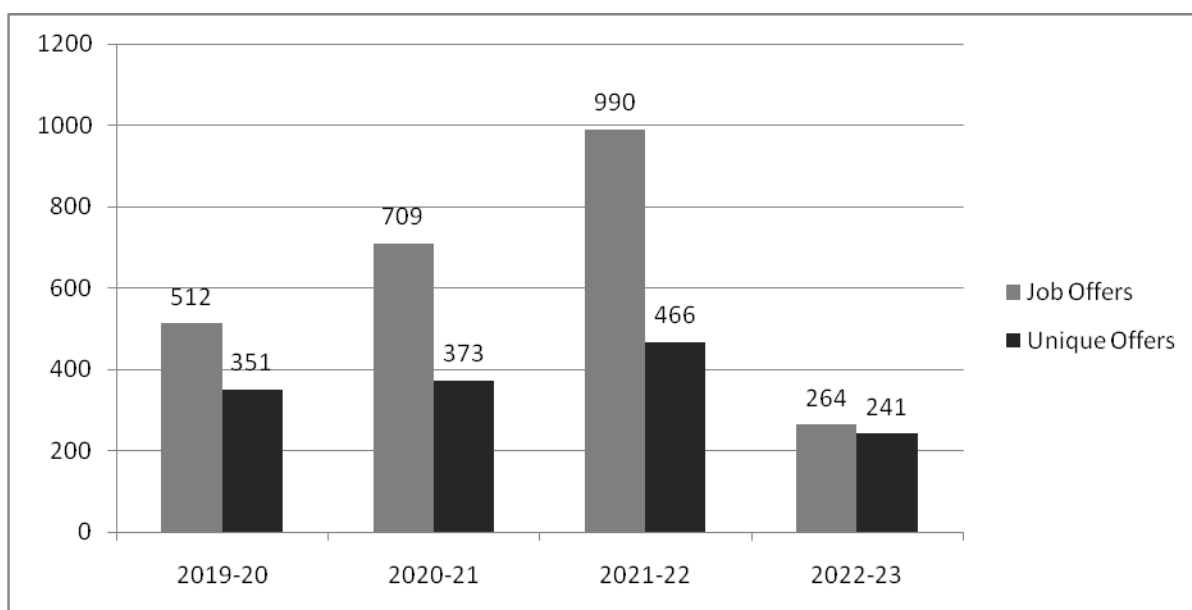
