- (iii) **New Courses:** Introduction of new Programmes BCA and BBA from Academic year 2024-25.

Suggestions given by the Governing Body Members

Chairman of Governing Body:

Mr.A.Vinay Kumar Reddy conveyed greetings to all Governing Body Members. He also agreed with every recommendation made by the members of the Governing Body.

Member Secretary, Ex-officio:

Dr. K.Sagar presented brief report about the college and other agenda items. All members approved the previous (22nd) Governing Body Minutes held on 18th January 2023.

He added that CRT classes C-Language, Java, Python Programming, and Data Structures & Algorithms, etc. programs are taught by in-house faculty and a few courses are taught by third party.

SIET entered a local chapter of NPTEL Top 100 in India.

The Governing Body introduced themselves with designations and roles. A few changes have been done in the governing body, Miss S.Bhavani - State Government Nominee, Dr.C.Krishna Mohan - Academician, and Dr. Suresh Akella - Faculty of the college existed from SIET Governing Body. The management thanked their contribution after the new members are welcomed into Governing Body Dr. C.Srinath – Joint Director of Technical Education and Training, Telangana State, Prof. Kumar Molugaram - Professor of Civil Engineering, University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad, and Mr. B.Sreenivasu - Associate Dean Academics & Associate Professor of ECE, SIET

Executive Member of Governing Body:

Mr. A.Hriday Reddy, Governing Body Executive Member, noted all the points suggested by the State Government Nominee, JNTUH nominee, and Educationalist nominee related to Mechanical and Civil Engineering Programmes.

He stated to have a memorandum of understanding with Smart Interviews to train in all areas, particularly aptitude, and to facilitate placements.

JNTUH Nominee:

Dr. N.V.S.Raju, Professor of Mechanical Engineering JNTUH, UCESTH, Hyderabad, recommended that the BBA program be started instead of the BCA, and that computer-related content be added to the Mechanical and Civil Engineering programs in accordance with current demand.

He went on to say that you should assess the current state of affairs and use SWOC analysis to determine your comparative advantages and potential avenues for performance improvement.

Industrialist (Nominated by the Management):

Mr. Goparapu Sreenivasa Rao, Managing Director, Global Pre Sales & Solutions, Hyderabad, appreciated the CRT and Placements' and upcoming events and plans in the college.

UGC Nominee:

Dr. S.Sireesh, Professor of Civil Engineering, IIT-Hyderabad suggested including Computer related courses in open and professional electives in Mechanical and Civil Engineering branches.

State Government Nominee:

Dr. C.Srinath suggested to take measures to improve students' enrolment in the Mechanical and Civil Engineering departments.

Academician nominated by the management:

Dr. Kumar Molugaram, Professor of Civil Engineering, University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad, suggested that to maintain an automated machine for the library log, he further stated that in addition to a physical register, maintain an RFID card for in and out timings.

He suggested that faculty members and students make better use of the digital library's resources. According to this perspective, professors encourage the students to use digital libraries to reference journals and advance in emerging fields.

Additionally, he advised conducting FDPs and SDPs in addition to putting into action a strategic plan aimed at improving placements for CSE and allied branches.

Mr.B.Sreenivasu suggested to improve consultancy in the campus.

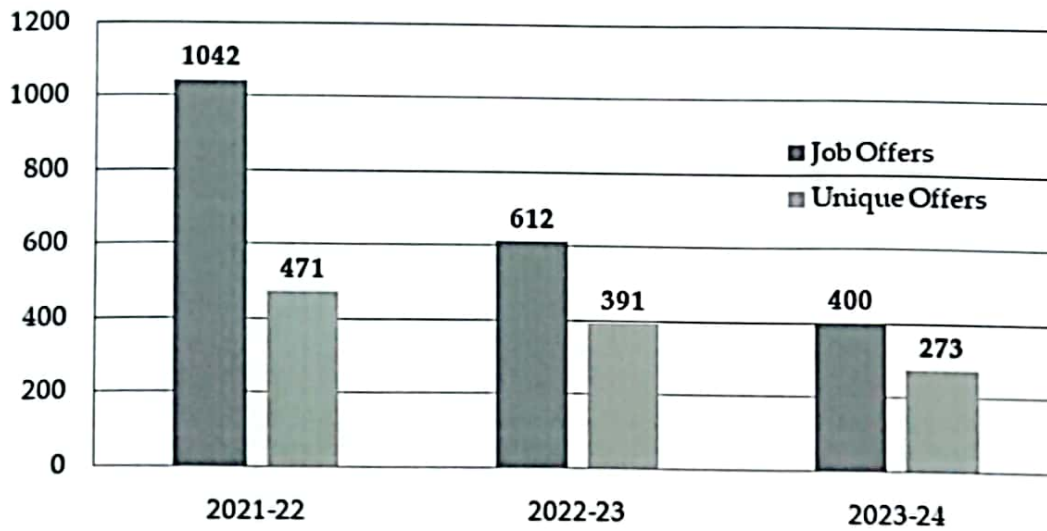
