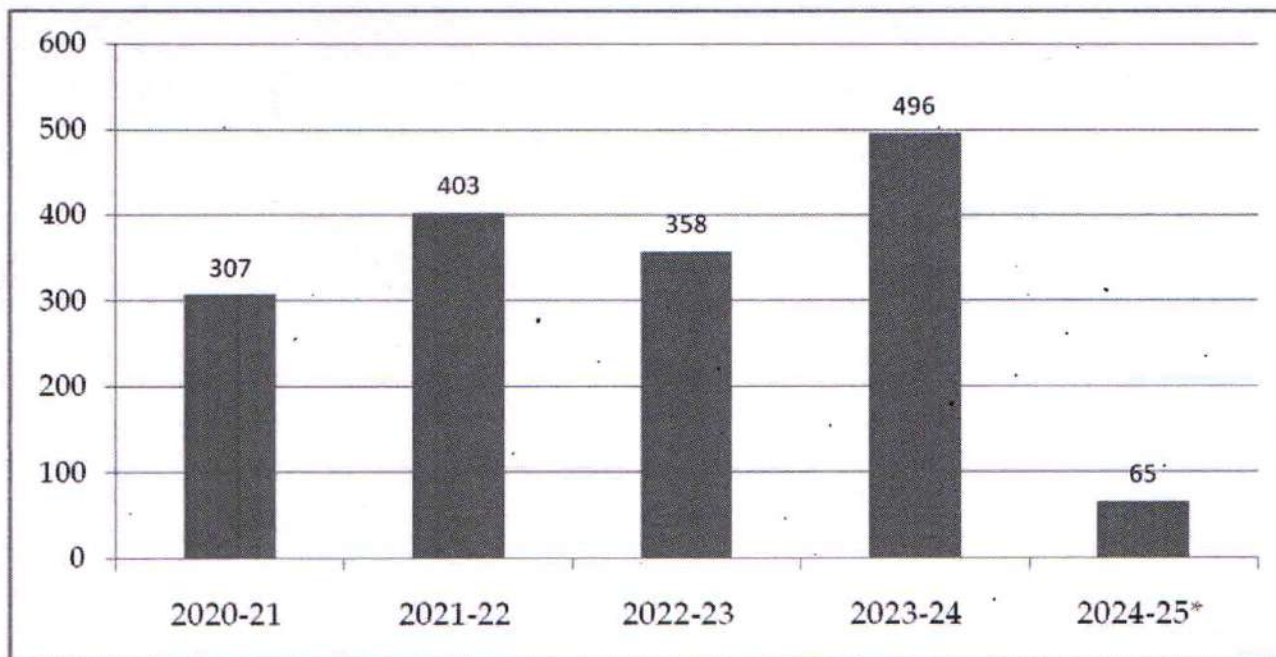

#### Lateral Entry Admitted Students (R22 Regulations):






















