

- (ii) Increase in B.Tech. CSE (Data Science) from 120 to 180, increase in B.Tech. CSE (AI&ML) from 120 to 180 and increase CSE from 240 to 300 from A.Y. 2023-24
Introduction of new Programme in B.Tech. Artificial Intelligence and Data Science (AI & DS) with 60 intake / B.Tech. Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AI & ML) with 60 intake / MCA / BBA / B.Arch. from Academic year 2023-24

Academician (Nominated by the Management): Dr. C. Krishna Mohan appreciated the CRT and Placements' improvements in the college.














